Coming up this half term...

In Maths this half term, we will be looking at Place Value using numbers up to ten million and then we will move onto Addition and Subtraction.

For English this half term, we will be looking at the Place Value of Punctuation and Grammar as well as reading our class novel- 'Cosmic' by Frank Cottrell-Boyce.

In Science, we will be looking at Earth and Space. We will learn about famous astronomers and then move on to looking closely at the Solar System.

In Geography this half term, we will be looking at the economic activity of the UK.

In R.E., we will be exploring 'Why do people believe that God exists?'

In Art, we will be following the Explore and Draw pathway looking at typography and how artists use fonts to create art.

In PSHRE, we will be looking at relationships in relation to how to disagree respectfully and communicate effectively.

Homework

Our homework project for this half-term is to design and create a space vehicle. Things to think about... what is its purpose? How does it move? You can either make a model or create a PowerPoint or a storyboard to share with the rest of the class.

The project is due in on Monday 21st October.

Even though the children have completed the official Multiplication Tables Check, we would still like the children to use TT Rockstars on a regular basis, focusing on the facts they find trickiest or by completing real-life word problems. Please encourage your child to use Spelling Shed to practise weekly spellings.
