Coming up this half term...

In Maths this half term, we will be looking at Decimals and Percentages and then move onto Perimeter and Area.

For English this half term, we will continue to use Raysha vs Aashman to inspire us to write a narrative. We will move onto writing our own biography about David Attenborough.

Our main reading text this half term will be Clockwork by Philip Pullman.

As Scientists we will look at Living Things and their habitats, focusing on reproduction in both plants and animals.

In Geography our topic is Rivers and Coasts. We will be looking at the different features of coasts as well as looking at the features of a river at each course and the specific features that can form.

As Design Technologists, we will be using textiles to help design and create our own sleep masks, ready for our trip to Nell Bank.

Homework

Our homework project for this half-term is to create a 3-D model of a coastal landscape, with different physical features such as cliffs, beaches, dunes, caves, and other features you will be learning about over the next couple of weeks. This could be in the form of a model (see attached sheet), detailed drawings, with descriptions or some form of ICT presentation.

Homework should be returned by Friday 28th March.
