Coming up this half term...

In Maths this half term, we will be looking at Perimeter and Area before moving onto Statistics.

For English this half term, we will be writing a persuasive job advert before moving onto Poetry.

Our main reading text this half term will be Holes by Louis Sachar focussing on character development and inferences. This novel has strong links to our previously studied topic 'Crime & Punishment'

As Scientists we will look at Animals including humans including: Gestation periods, Prenatal Development, Growth and Development of Babies and Children, Puberty and Adolescence, Late Adulthood and the Human Timeline

In History our topic is Ancient Greece. We will find out about who the Ancient Greeks were and start to understand how significant Ancient Greece achievements were in influencing life in Britain up to the present day.

As Design Technologists, we will continue to use textiles to help design and create our own sleep masks and then move onto designing and creating our own marble run.

As musicians, we will create a vocal composition and work as a group to perform a piece of music.

Homework

Our homework project for this half-term is to create an Ancient Greek themed maze puzzle. This can either be a 3D model, a computerised maze (within a PowerPoint) or a maze drawn/painted on paper.

Homework should be returned by Monday 19th May.
